Public transport

Arriva Sapphire - Route 280

If you're heading to the station from Thame then you could catch the 280 bus which runs between Aylesbury and Oxford. The service operates 7 days a week, up to every 20 minutes with bus stops at Thame Town Hall and the police station. Sapphire buses offer a premium service with free WiFi, plug sockets, stylish seating and audio and video announcements, so you can relax on your commute to the station.

Walking and cycling

Haddenham is mostly flat and its residential areas are well connected by a network of quiet roads, which are ideal for walking and cycling. Walking from the other side of Haddenham to the station only takes 20 minutes whilst cycling only takes 6 minutes.

Cyclists can park their bikes in sheltered parking near the station ticket office. With over 100 free spaces there is plenty of room to lock your bike up safely.
