We do not provide private flu vaccinations; these are widely available from pharmacies and supermarkets.

Travel Clinic

Need advice on travel immunisations? Our Nurse Manager Jenny Pullen provides a Travel Clinic on a Tuesday morning and also at our Saturday clinics. Jenny can offer a full range of foreign travel immunisations, malaria prevention and personalised advice. Try to make your first appointment about eight weeks before you travel in case a course of vaccinations is necessary. You will be asked to complete a travel questionnaire before booking the appointment to enable us to assess the risks (and may even mean an appointment is not necessary if you are up to date with vaccinations). This will ask about where you are going, what kind of transport you might use, what level of accommodation you will have and what activities you might be doing. These can be obtained from reception or downloaded from our website.
