# Haddenham Scarecrow Festival 2-19 June 2022

Haddenham Association of Scouts & Guides is delighted to present our 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Scarecrow Festival, starting on the first day of the Platinum Jubilee weekend

# Entries open 7<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> May

Entries can be submitted any time from 7<sup>th</sup> May until midnight 25<sup>th</sup> May. All entries submitted by the closing date will be included on the official List of Entrants and Scarecrow Trail Map. Unfortunately, any entries received late, even the next day, cannot be included on the official map due to the very tight printing deadline, but late entrants are welcome to display their scarecrow in support of the event. Copies of the official Scarecrow Trail Map will be made available both online and from outlets in the village (full details will follow).

We are challenging people to use their imagination and creativity to make a Scarecrow *using any resources you may have* at home, in your loft, garden, shed or garage – no need to buy anything and no need to include straw unless you already have some or would prefer to do so. There are very few rules to follow:

- 1. Your Scarecrow can be ANY shape or size and made of any material or item(s).
- 2. "Platinum jubilee" themed entries are welcome, but this is entirely optional
- 3. All scarecrows or displays MUST be given a name. With a village-wide event on this scale, some name duplications are inevitable, but each and every creation is unique and appreciated, so please don't worry about this.
- 4. Entries MUST be visibly displayed *at the front of your own property* 24 hours a day from 9am on 2<sup>nd</sup> June (*NOT BEFORE PLEASE*) until the end of Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> June.
- 5. We kindly request that scarecrows are not used to make political statements or presented in any way which may cause offence to any spectators, especially young children it just needs to be fun!

Passers-by will be able to follow the Trail and enjoy the Scarecrows whilst walking around the village. We request visitors do not enter on to private property unless invited to do so. We will also arrange to display the scarecrows "virtually" for anyone unable to go out to see for themselves.

To take part, simply complete and return an entry form to register your Scarecrow.
