

## CHILDREN'S CLASSES FOR HHS SHOW 3/9/16

1. Entry is free to Classes 201 - 248.
2. No entry can be accepted unless the date of birth (D.O.B) of the child is given on the entry form. Prizes may not be awarded if the exhibits are not to the standard expected of children of the relevant age.
3. Children's exhibits should be the unaided work of the exhibitor but in photography classes 210, 229 & 248 normal retail film processing and printing of images from film or digital memory is permitted.
4. **Please use a separate entry form for each child's entries.**
5. Rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> places and the Rotary Club Prize Voucher will be awarded for one outstanding exhibit.
6. Trophy winners in each section will also receive commemorative medals or shields.

### **CLASSES OPEN TO ALL CHILDREN UNDER 16 YEARS OF AGE ON 1st SEPTEMBER)**

201. A collection of marzipan fruits, exhibited on a paper plate not more than 20cm diameter.
202. A model crown (not more than 20cm diameter).

#### **A. CHILDREN UNDER 7 YEARS OF AGE ON 1st SEPTEMBER.**

(Exhibits not to exceed A4 size or 30cm x 21cm)

203. Funny person or animal made from one or more vegetables.
204. A painting or drawing of a monster.
205. Arrangement of flower heads in a saucer.
206. A selection of grasses arranged for decorative effect in a jam jar.
207. A bookmark in any medium.
208. A bead picture.
209. A decorated hard-boiled egg.
210. "MY BEST FRIEND". A single photograph, not larger than 6" x 4", taken by the exhibitor and mounted.

#### **B. CHILDREN 7 AND OVER, BUT UNDER 11 YEARS OF AGE ON 1st SEPTEMBER.**

(Exhibits not to exceed A4 size or 30cm x 21cm unless otherwise stated)

#### **ARTS AND CRAFTS**

211. Compose a limerick.
212. A drawing or painting of a person or animal using any medium.
213. Design a greetings card using any medium (size: A4 folded in half).
214. A bookmark in any medium.
215. Any piece of embroidery work.
216. A decorated paper plate (not more than 20cm diameter).
217. An item made from recycled material.
218. Animal or person made from natural vegetables and/or fruit.
219. Any model made from clay.
220. A model made from LEGO or similar on a base approx 25cm x 25cm.
221. A glove puppet.
222. A necklace of fruit.
223. A painted or decorated stone, not to exceed 20cm in any direction.

#### **COOKERY**

224. Six scones, cheese (oven baked).
225. Six fairy cakes (iced).

#### **PLANTS**

226. A floral arrangement, including foliage, in a cup and saucer.
227. A miniature garden depicted in a seed tray (max. size: 37cm x 24cm).
228. A garden design plan (A4 sheet, computer-aided designs permitted).

#### **PHOTOGRAPHY**

229. "MY BEST FRIEND". A single photograph, not larger than 6" x 4", taken by the exhibitor and mounted.

### **C. CHILDREN 11 AND OVER, BUT UNDER 16 YEARS OF AGE ON 1st SEPTEMBER.**

(Exhibits not to exceed A4 size or 30cm x 21cm unless otherwise stated)

#### **ARTS AND CRAFTS**

- 230. Compose a poem celebrating an event of 2016.
- 231. A drawing or painting of a garden using any medium.
- 232. Design a greetings card using any medium (size: A4 folded in half).
- 233. A bookmark in any medium.
- 234. Any piece of embroidery work.
- 235. Jewellery made from pasta.
- 236. An item made from recycled material.
- 237. An item made from papier mache.
- 238. Model of a space ship in any other material. Not a kit or LEGO or similar.
- 239. A model made from LEGO or similar on a base approx 25cm x 25cm.
- 240. A puppet (string or glove)
- 241. A collage of pulses (peas, beans, etc.)
- 242. Design and make a board game (rules to be included).

#### **COOKERY**

- 243. Shortbread, approx 18 cm diameter and uncut.
- 244. Six rock cakes.

#### **PLANTS**

- 245. A garden design plan (A4 sheet, computer-aided designs permitted).
- 246. Six stems of garden flowers in a jam jar arranged for decorative effect.
- 247. "THIS GREEN AND PLEASANT LAND" An arrangement of natural plant material, accessories permitted (not to exceed 35cm in any direction).

#### **PHOTOGRAPHY**

- 248. "MY BEST FRIEND". A single photograph, not larger than 6" x 4", taken by the exhibitor and mounted.
