The budgeted costs per tree is £50 which includes for the purchase of a 2/3 year old sapling together with the requirements for compost, protection and support. Each sponsor will receive a certificate of recognition in addition to a record on the acknowledgment board that will be located at the entrance to the orchard.

The concept of a community orchard is that fruit is free for all members of the community: no one has any more right to the produce than any other. Donors have the satisfaction of knowing that they have contributed to this little oasis in the village.
